BERTH INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION

- Name of the berth: **JUAN SEBASTIAN ELCANO, no. C002 (Cruise Terminal).**
 - Length of the berth: 700 meters.
 - The height of the quay is of 2 meters. approx. Depth at HW-12 meters - no tides and Depth at LW-12 meters - no tides.
 - The fenders used along the dock are rubber cylindrical fenders.
 - The maximum draft is of 11,25 meters.
 - The distance between bollards is of 30 meters. Approx., and the strength is between 100 Tn – 150 Tn. They are made of steel.
 - No shore gangways available.
 - Names of alternative berths: Santa Lucia, Nº C008/C009 (Commercial Terminal) with 385 meters, San Pedro, Nº C010/C011 (General Cargo Terminal) with 405 meters, and La Curra, (Pier owned by Naval Authority) with around 400 meters.
- Position of all vessel's arriving at Cartagena is Latitude 37º 32'N and Longitude 001º 00'W
- Before arrival to the mentioned position vessel must contact Cartagena Port Control 2 hrs. in advance. (Enclosed Cartagena Port Control Protocol for your reference)
- Pilot boarding position is Latitude 37º 34,3'N and Longitude 000º 59,5W
- VHF channel 14 to contact Cartagena Port Control and pilot.
- Speed required when approaching port for pilot boarding is 5 to 9 knots.
- The pilot ladder must be one meter above the sea level for boarding.

RESTRICTIONS

- Fuel bunkering is not allowed in the Cruise Terminal.
- Restricted to burn the ships incinerator whilst in port.
- No air draught restriction.

TUGS INFORMATION

- Tugs available: Five
- Horsepower: 2398-5258 HP
- The use of Tugs is NOT COMPULSORY. Tugs shall be requested as per Master and Pilots criteria.
- One hour NOTICE required.
- Cost as followed: (The price would be the same whether vessel uses 1 or the 5 tugs available on arrival and departure. It is a flat rate applied)
 - Ships up to 30.000 GT = 5.161,00€ Lumpsum.
 - Ships from 30.001 to 65.000 GT = 7.377,00€ Lumpsum.
 - Ships from 65.001 GT onwards = 8.839,00€ Lumpsum.
 - The stand-by fee is approx. 35 % of the tariff, depending on the quantity of tugs used and duration of the manoeuvring.

TOURIST AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- The berth is in the same city, 5 minutes walking distance to the centre of the city.
- Local Time in Cartagena is GMT +1 (WINTER) & GMT +2 (SUMMER).
- Taxis are available by the main gate of the Cruise Terminal and if requested in advance we can arrange permissions for driver to come inside the pier for any particular service

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required. The cost for transportation to the centre of the city is approx. 5'00 €, although Town Centre is just 300 meters far from the pier.

- The nearest airport is CORVERA airport (RMU) in Murcia, which is around 30 minutes' drive from Cartagena, cost of taxi approx. 80,00 €.
- The nearest international airport is Alicante airport (ALC) which is around 1 hour drive from Cartagena, cost of taxi approx. 165,00 €.
- There is no shuttle service available since pier is in the same city and therefore not needed.
- No currency exchange office available but in the main avenue named "Calle Mayor", nearby the Cruise Terminal, there are many banks with ATM machines.
- The currency is EURO (€) and no other currency accepted in shops or restaurants.
- Western Union office available in same Post Office. In the centre of the city, around 15 minutes walking distance.
- Cost of postage stamps for letters up to 20 grams for Europe is 1.25 € and for USA or rest of the world is 1,35 €.
- There is a double-decker tourist bus available about 200 mtrs. from the terminal which does an itinerary through the city every hour.
